the information. The PAC will not publish the list. Parents who wish to get it will have to contact the PAC. The PAC is acting as an intermediary and therefore accepts no responsibility under any circumstances.

Remember your Thrifty's Smile Card this summer!

There is no more deadline to charge money to the Thrifty's cards. You can now charge them even in the Summer. These cards let you buy your merchandise as usual, but Thrifty gives back to the PAC 5% of all purchases made through the cards linked to our school, up to \$2,500. This year, we are spending those funds to help with the acquisition of musical instruments for our students. The Smile card is free. All you have to do is get one at the front desk at school, *LOAD MONEY ON IT AT THE STORE BEFORE YOU MAKE YOUR PURCHASES*, then use it to pay for your groceries.

Fairway Market card

We have received the new Fairway Market cards. You use them to buy your merchandise as usual, but Fairway Market gives back to the PAC 5% of all purchases made through the cards linked to our school, with no limit! We'll be spending those funds to help finance school activities. The Fairway Market card is free. All you have to do is get one at the front desk at school, *LOAD MONEY ON IT AT THE STORE BEFORE YOU MAKE YOUR PURCHASES*, then use it to pay for your groceries. There are not deadline to load money onto the cards and you can use it all year round.
